YOUTHFEST – BEAUTY CATEGORY (4 SUB – EVENTS)

RULES:

- Each Participant is permitted to take part in only one of the four activities
- All participants must bring their own products, tools, and equipment
- Model must be arranged by the participant from their own college, but they cannot assist the participant.
- Self-application or performing the activity on oneself is strictly prohibited.
- No external help is allowed during the competition.
- Cleanliness, hygiene, and safety must be strictly followed.
- No phones or any other electronic device allowed for reference purpose.

1. MEHENDI ART COMPETITION

Theme: (Bridal/Arabic/any other) Time Limit: 2Hrs- 2.5Hrs.

- Participants must bring their own mehendi cones.
- Only freehand designs allowed — no stencils, pre-made templates, or stickers.
- Design must be in both the hands (front) of minimum 6'inch on each.
- Use of glitter, stones, or any decorative add-ons won't be permitted.

2. MAKE UP COMPETITION

Theme Choices: Party/Evening Glam Time Limit: 2Hrs.

- Participants must bring their complete makeup kit including brushes, tools, sanitizers, etc.
- Base makeup must be blended properly. Hairstyles are not included in it.
- No pre-done base or prepped skin on the model—skin must be clean at the start.
- Use of prosthetics, body paint, or heavy SFX is not allowed. False lashes are allowed but must be applied within the time limit.

3. HAIR STYLE COMPETITION

Time Limit: 1.5 Hrs.

- Participants must bring all their own styling tools (combs, rods/curlers/straightener, clips, and pins).
- Heat tools allowed only with proper safety precautions.
- Use of pre-styled hair extensions (only buns) is allowed, if you fix them during the time limit.
- No pre-done curls or braids on the model—hair must be open at the start.
- The hairstyle should be long-lasting and neat.

4. NAIL ART COMPETITION

Time Limit: 1Hr. Choice: Press-on nail

- Participants must bring their own nail polishes, tools, brushes, UV lamps (if using gel), and decor items.
- No pre-painted nails — nails must be clean at the start.
- Use of stones, and glitters is allowed depending on your event style.
- Press-ons must be designed onsite.

:: OTHER COMPETITION RULES ::

REEL MAKING COMPETITION- ON THE SPOT

Time: 30 min. (Editing Only)

- Solo or team of upto 2 members.
- No pre-recorded clips, templates, or prior footage, pre-planned scripts, outfits, props, or external help are allowed.
- Participants must stay within the event area. Use of Background music is permitted; however, the external voice of the reel makers or any live narration/opinion will not be allowed in the final reel.
- The mode of submission would be in file form to avoid any hampering of video quality

DEBATE COMPETITION

Time Limit: 40 min.

- Team Entry of 6 members (3-proposition,3-opposition)
- Opening speech- For/Against the motion-5 minutes each, Rebuttal – 15 minutes, Jury question 5 minute, Closing Statement- 5 minutes each
- No offensive language or personal remarks
- Use clear, logical and relevant points.
- Maintain discipline; don't interrupt others.
- Rebuttal must be polite and within time.
- No reading from paper or use of mobiles/electronic gadgets allowed.
- Speech must be original and free from offensive, political, religious or abusive content.
- **Sub Topics:**
 - Does Swadeshi boost India's Economy?
 - Should Youth prefer Swadeshi Goods?
 - Is Swadeshi a need or just an Emotion?
 - Is "Vocal for Local" the new Swadeshi?
- Finale round topic will be given on the spot.
(Hint: Global Politics, Current Affairs)

MINI SHARK TANK

Time Limit: 20 min.

- Individual or team of up to 2 members.
- A unique team name is mandatory.

Idea Submission

Participants must submit:

- Business idea summary (150–250 words)
- Problem statement and Target audience
- Proposed solution and Approx. budget/financial plan (optional but recommended)

Pitch Presentation Rules

Each team gets:

- 7-10 minutes for pitch
- 7-10 minutes for judges' Q&A

Presentation format can be:

- PPT, Chart Papers, Model, Demo App/Website

FOLK DANCE (TEAM ENTRY)

Time Limit: upto 7 min.

- Team Entry for min. 5- max. 12 members
- Teams must register with all member names before the deadline.
- Performance must be based on traditional or regional folk dance forms of India or any culture. Fusion is strictly prohibited. No offensive, or non-folk elements allowed.
- Teams must submit their final music track in MP3 format at least 6 days before the event. Bring a backup on pen drive. No changes allowed after submission.
- Costumes should reflect the authentic folk style of the chosen region. Props are allowed but should be safe and easy to handle. Dangerous items (fire, sharp objects, liquids, powders) are strictly prohibited. Teams are responsible for their own costumes and props.
- Any damage to stage property will result in disqualification. All team members must be present 30 minutes before performance.

AI in Branding – On-the-Spot Task

Time Limit: 45-60 min.

- The branding brief/topic will be given on the spot. (E.g., design a logo, tagline, mini campaign, brand identity, etc.)
- Individual or team of up to 2 members.
- Only On-device AI image generators are allowed. No prior templates, pre-made designs, or previous brand projects are allowed.
- No external downloads during the competition (fonts, assets, stock images). All content must be created during the event only.

EXTEMPORE COMPETITION

Time limit: 3 min.

- Max. 01 participant.
- Topics will be given on the spot. No change allowed.
- Participants get 1 minute to think and 2 minutes to speak.
- No mobile phones or written notes are allowed.
- Speech must be original and free from offensive, political, religious or abusive content.

:: GENERAL RULES ::

- **REGISTRATION FEE RS. 100/- PER INDIVIDUAL PER ENTRY. LAST DATE OF REG. : 30TH JANUARY, 2026**
- I-card/Adhaar Card is mandatory.
- Each participant is permitted to register for only 1 event except mini shark tank and folk dance.
- Registration is mandatory within stipulated time.
- Any form of misconduct may lead to disqualification.
- Participants have to bring their own materials, costumes etc. Organizers are not responsible for any loss or damage of personal belongings.
- Participants must follow rule and time for every event. If not, will lead to disqualification.
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding to all.
- Organizer will not be responsible for any technical failures, power outages or unforeseen circumstances.
- Organizer have rights to modify or change rules, schedules, events etc. if necessary and it will be well communicated to all in advance.
- The decision of organizer regarding any event will be final and binding to all.
- No TA-DA will be provided by the college.
